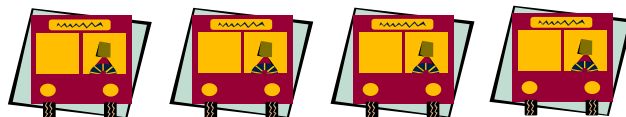

Join Janice for **"Chair" Yoga** on **Thursdays, May 2nd, May 9th, 16th, 23rd** and **May 30th**.



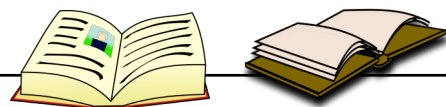

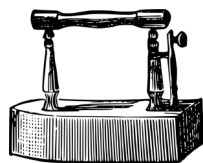
