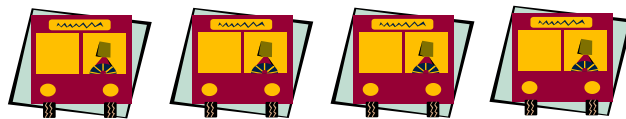

## "Creative Crafts with Maureen"

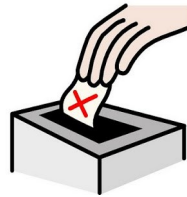
This month we are making Decoupage Photo Frames.
