Visiting your loved one at Gurwin Jewish~Fay J. Lindner Residences FORMAL VISITATION PLAN

At Gurwin Jewish~Fay J. Lindner Residences, we are delighted to welcome you back! Our residents have missed you - our staff has missed you - and we are pleased that we are finally able to see you again!

You will notice right away that visits are not the same as you are used to. We have prepared this simple document for you, so you know what to expect and that your visit goes smoothly. At any time, of course, you may call (631) 715-8500 or email info@gurwin.org with questions.

VISITING INFORMATION

- Visits are held daily: Monday through Friday at 9:30 am, 10:00 am, 3:30 pm and 4:00 pm; Saturday and Sunday at 9:30 am, 10:00 am, 2:30 pm and 3:00 pm. They can be scheduled with our Recreation Department by emailing fajjvideochat@gurwin.org.
- Visits will take place in our main lobby.
- Each resident visit is limited to two family members.
- All visitors must be at least 18 years of age, or accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age.
- Each visitor in the family must be screened and must wear a mask during the entire visit.

PROCEDURE

- Upon arrival, please park in the main parking lot and proceed to the front entrance. As you enter, you will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, which will include a temperature check and questions regarding your current state of health and recent travel.
- All visitors must wear a mask when entering the facility and at all times during their visit.
- Any items you might have for your loved one should be left in the lobby at check-in, and we will deliver them to the room. You will not be able to personally give your loved one anything during your visit.
- Visits will take place at a table in the lobby, with our resident at one end of the table and visitors at the other end, to assure social distancing.
- You will be directed to use hand sanitizer as you approach the table.
- Please respect the Department of Health's social distancing requirement by refraining from physical contact with your loved one.
- In order to accommodate the maximum number of residents possible, all visits will last for 15 minutes.
- Entrance to any other part of the facility besides the visitation area in the lobby is prohibited at any time during the visit, including use of the rest rooms. We apologize for any inconvenience, however, these are requirements from the Department of Health.
- All visits will be monitored by a Gurwin staff member.
- Before leaving your visit, please perform hand hygiene using the alcohol-based hand sanitizer at the table.
