



In-Person Visits at Gurwin Jewish Nursing & Rehabilitation Center

At Gurwin Jewish Nursing & Rehabilitation Center, we are delighted to welcome you back! Our residents have missed you - our staff has missed you - and we are pleased that we are finally able to see you again!

You will notice right away that visits are not the same as you are used to. We have prepared this simple document for you, so you know what to expect once In-person visits commence, and so that your visit goes smoothly. VISITING INFORMATION

- In-person visits are held Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Visits are 15 minutes in duration. Time slots include 9:30 am, 10:00 am, 10:30 am, 11:00 am, 1:30 pm, 2:00 pm, 2:30 pm and 3:00 pm. They can be scheduled through Sign Up Genius online at bit.ly/GurwinVisits.
- Drive-Up visits will continue on Tuesdays, Thursdays and two Sundays a month, and will run every 15 minutes between 9:15 am and 11:45 am and from 1:30 pm to 3:15 p.m. These can also be scheduled through Sign Up Genius.
- In-person visits will take place in our Adult Day Care Activity Room in the rear of the Gurwin building.
- Each resident is entitled to two guests per visit in our Activity Room; three separate, concurrent family visits is the maximum capacity for each time slot.
- All visitors must be at least 18 years of age, or accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age.
- Each visitor in the family must be screened upon entry, complete a screening form, and **provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test administered within seven days of the visit.**
- Visitors must wear a mask or face covering when entering the building and during the entire visit.

PROCEDURE

- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your visit and check-in at Adult Day Care entrance for screening which will include a temperature check, questions regarding your current state of health and recent travel, and completion of a screening form. You must present at this time a verified negative COVID-19 test result within the last 7 days.
- You will be directed to use the alcohol-based hand sanitizer located at the screening table.
- Any items you might have for your loved one must be left in the **front lobby** prior to proceeding to the Adult Day Care Activity Room area, and we will deliver them to the residents' room. You will not be able to personally give your loved one anything during your visit.
- After checking in and being screened, you will be instructed to proceed to the Adult Day Care Activity Room for your visit.
- Visits will take place at a table, with our resident at one end of the table and visitors at the other end, to assure social distancing.
- Please respect the Department of Health's social distancing requirement by refraining from physical contact with your loved one.
- Rest rooms will not be available for use during your visit. We apologize for any inconvenience; however, this is requirements from the Department of Health.
- All visits will be monitored by a Gurwin staff member. Anyone who does not adhere to social distancing rules may be asked to leave and forfeit future visiting privileges.
- Before leaving your visit, please perform hand hygiene using the alcohol-based hand sanitizer at the table.
- In the case of inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, we will contact you if your visit needs to be postponed or canceled. Should this occur, we will do our very best to provide an alternate time for a make-up visit. We appreciate your understanding.
